Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer. The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality reviewing hearing information before the Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:37-13.2 et. seq., attorney-client privilege, personnel, and negotiations, and;

**WHEREAS**, the length of the Executive Session is estimated to be one hundred eighty (180) minutes after which the meeting may reconvene and proceed with business.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Clinton Township Board of Education will go into Executive Session for only the above stated reasons;
