Clinton Township Board of Education Open Board Seat Notification July 2018

In June 2018, the Board of Education announced the availability of an open board seat on the Clinton Township Board of Education. The Board invited all interested candidates an opportunity to apply for an interview for this open seat by Wednesday, July 18, 2018. The Board's intent was to interview candidates during their monthly board meeting held on July 23, 2018.

Due to new, unexpected business of the Board that was required to be addressed during the July 23rd meeting, the Board was not able to interview prospective candidates during that meeting. Therefore, the Board would like to announce that they will interview all prospective candidates during a special meeting to be held on Tuesday, July 31st in the auditorium at the Clinton Township Middle School at 7:30 pm.

Interested candidates that have not expressed interest for this open seat, and would like to do so, may submit their name, address, a phone number, and an e-mail address, along with a letter of interest and a resume for consideration no later than 4 pm on Thursday, July 26 , 2018. Anyone that has submitted a letter of interest are not required to resubmit the above information.

Interested candidates must meet a qualification under N.J.S.A. 18A:12.1. He/she must be a citizen and resident of Clinton Township for at least one year, be a registered voter, be able to read and write and notwithstanding the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:51-1 or other law to the contrary, he/she is not disqualified as voter pursuant to R.S. 19:4-1.
