Dear PMG Families,

I hope your summer has been relaxing and enjoyable! The beginning of the school year is quickly approaching and I am very excited to begin a new year of learning. The entire PMG staff and I are looking forward to meeting our new second grade students and seeing our third graders again. We have been busy preparing the school for the new year. Schedules are made, class lists are complete, and the hallways and classrooms all sparkle!

We look forward to you visiting us on August 31. More details on this visitation and other important notes are listed below. You will also find an "Information at a Glance" document providing important contact and procedural information along with an automatic dismissal form attached to this summer packet.

**School Visitation:** Visitation is scheduled for Thursday, August 31 from 1:30-2:30 pm. This visitation time will give you an opportunity to take a walk through the building, visit new classrooms and say a quick hello to teachers.

**Drop-Off:** Morning arrivals start at 8:30 am. Staff members will meet children at the curb of the side parking lot at this time. Please do not get out of your cars; the staff will help assist the children (as needed) as they exit the passenger side of the vehicle. It is very important to keep the car-line moving, as many of our parents have other schools or jobs to get to. If you must get out of your car, please be sure to park in an assigned spot in the parking lot. For safety reasons, students are not permitted to enter the building earlier than 8:30 am to be sure the staff is on duty. Please DO NOT use the front of the school for drop-off. The front lot is reserved for staff vehicles and buses only.

Important Pick-Up and Dismissal Information: On September 5, 6 and 7 we will assume that your child is riding the bus home unless we receive a daily note that he/she is getting picked up or staying for Work Family Connection. A form is attached to this email and will also be sent home on the first day of school. Please use this form to indicate regularly occurring pick up days or Work Family days, thus eliminating the need to write a note each day. The information on this form will take effect on Monday, September 11, 2017. Dismissal begins at 3:10. Two doors on the side of the building (gym doors) will open. You will need to show identification (until staff members get to know you) and then we will release your child to you. If you need to pick up your child earlier than dismissal time for an unavoidable reason, please do so BEFORE 2:45 pm and pick up your child from the main office. Please be sure to send all changes in normal dismissal routines in writing to the office first thing in the morning. Please do not email teachers with dismissal changes. For safety reasons, we are unable to accept dismissal changes over the phone.

<u>Communication</u>: In the event of an emergency school closing or unexpected situation, parents will be notified via phone and email through the Clinton Township School District (CTSD) alert system. In addition, each month a newsletter will be sent to PMG families with upcoming events and important school/district news. <u>Parent Portal</u>: Is part of the district's PowerSchool student information system. Parent Portal allows parents/guardians to view their students' grades and attendance, submit updated contact information, and get in touch with teachers via email. Please note that if you have not previously setup your guardian account, you will need the linking codes (Access ID and Access Password) unique to each student to link pupils to your login. These codes are sent out early in the school. If you have not received your access code/information or are having difficulty accessing the site, please email:parenthelp@ctsdnj.org. **Bus Information:** You should have received information regarding your child's bus route. If you did not, please contact the transportation office. PMG buses are numbered P1- P10.

If you have questions related to transportation, please first email Mrs. Debbie Krupp at transportation@ctsdnj.org. The transportation phone number is 908-236-7235: press 9, then ext 512.

- The drivers WILL NOT release children at their bus stop unless a parent/guardian is present.
- Students are not permitted to ride a different bus than assigned.
- Students are permitted to get off their own bus at a different stop, if we have a written note from both the sending and receiving parent/guardian. A bus pass will be delivered to students in their homeroom.

**Attendance:** One of the most important things your child can do to achieve academic success is also one of the most basic: going to school every day. In fact, research has shown that your child's attendance record may be the biggest factor influencing their academic success. Our school day begins at 8:50. At 8:30 students begin to go to their classrooms and get ready for the school day.

**Tardiness:** Students who arrive to class after 8:50 a.m. are considered tardy. Students who are tardy miss the beginning of their morning classes and lose valuable instructional time. Tardiness can disrupt the attention of the teacher and the learning of fellow students. Please keep these thoughts in mind when bringing your child to school. We know there are times when tardiness cannot be avoided due to unexpected situations. Planning for an 8:30 a.m. arrival may help alleviate some of these stressful situations.

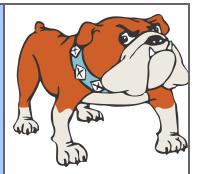

# Morning Drop-Off and Parking

Drop offs are in the side lot only, beginning at 8:30 am when staff members are present.. In order to keep the car line flowing, and to keep everyone safe, please do not get out of cars. Staff members will be available to assist students as they exit from the passenger (curb) side, as needed. If you do need to get out of the car, please park and utilize the sidewalk.

#### Afternoon Pick-Up and Dismissal

Dismissal begins at 3:10. At this time a side gym door will open. Please have identification with you. All pick-ups should be completed by 3:20.

On the occasion that you need to pick your child up early, please send in a note and indicate a time before 2:45. We will add your child's name to the early pick-up list. Early pick-ups are facilitated in the main office. After 2:45, all pickups will be in the gym.

#### <u>Absences</u>

If your child is absent or tardy, please call and leave a message on our early alert line. Please share the followina: Your name Child's name Reason for absence or Anticipated time of arrival (for tardy students) 908.735.5151 press 1 We are required to verify each absence, so if you do not leave a message on early alert, you will receive a phone call from the office.

#### <u> Allergies</u>

PMG has a number of students with life-threatening food allergies. In order to maintain a safe environment for everyone, all classrooms are peanut and tree nut free for snacks. Some classrooms may have additional restrictions. This restriction is only for classroom snacks. Students are permitted to bring any type of lunch to the cafeteria.

## Notes from Home

Please direct all notes to your child's homeroom teacher and always include the date, teacher's name and your child's name. If you go away without your children, please notify the office in writing of the name of the person who will be in charge of your child. We will not release children to anyone not on your emergency contact sheet, including grandparents and siblings unless we have written permission from parents.

#### Parties

#### Progress Reporting

Conferences are held at the conclusion of the first marking period. At this time, progress will be documented on a conference report form.

At the conclusion of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th marking periods, grades are posted in the Parent Portal of Power School. In addition to the descriptor grades, teachers write comments, specific to each child. These can be found by clicking on the dash "-" under the homeroom box for each marking period.

If at any other time you have questions or concerns about your child's progress, please contact his/her teacher.

## PMG- Where Friendships Grow

Our school-wide theme is "Where Friendships Grow", and will be centered around our bulldog, Buddy, this year. During second and third grade students are working on developing friendships, with other individual students and groups of students. We promote our school rules of:
